After last spring frost  
Zones 2-11 | Annual



**ZINNIAS**

After last spring frost  
Zones 3-10 | Annual



**CONEFLOWERS**

Spring | Zones 3-9  
Perennial



**JACOB'S LADDER**

Spring or fall | Zones 3-8  
Perennial



**LAVENDER**

Late spring | Zones 5-9  
Perennial



**SHASTA DAISIES**

Spring or fall | Zones 5-8  
Perennial



**ROSES**

Late spring through  
early summer  
Zones 3-10 | Perennial



**BLACK-EYED  
SUSANS**

Late spring through  
early summer  
Zones 3-9 | Perennial



**BIG-LEAF  
HYDRANGEAS**

Late spring or early fall  
Zones 5-7 | Perennial



**TULIPS**

September through  
October | Zones 4-8  
Perennial (treat as annual)



**PEONIES**

September through early  
October  
Zones 3-8 | Perennial



Planting zones are based  
on average minimum  
temperature. Northeast  
planting zones range  
from 3 (cold) to 7 (mild).
