

Boyden Library Home Delivery Program

Boyden Library's Home Delivery Program delivers library materials to Foxborough residents who are unable to visit the library due to a physical condition.

A Foxborough resident requesting homebound delivery must meet the criteria established by the Board of Library Trustees.

- Permanent physical disabilities that prevents visiting the library.
- Temporary physical limitation that restricts visiting the library.
- Mobility issues that prohibits an individual from visiting the library.

Materials will be selected by a librarian that meets the needs and interests of the homebound patron. All attempts will be made to select appropriate items however; the library is not responsible for the content of materials.

If you do not have a Library Card, one may be obtained with proof of identification. Homebound patrons are responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged materials and must follow the rules and regulations of a Boyden Library card holder.
