Trustee Report – Kevin Penders looks forward to working with the 2 newly elected Trustees as Jeff Lovely and Janet Pineault who worked so tirelessly for the library for so many years chose not to run for reelection. The new leadership will be coming to the Trustees mid-May meeting. He is looking forward to moving the books into the new library. **"Meet Boyden Library Donor Night" will be June 20, Thursday, from 7-9 PM.** Contributors of \$500 or more will be invited. The affair will be catered and a 3 piece band "Horns in the House" will provide the music. This is their way of saying Thank You to everyone involved in the renovation project. Kevin is happy that the collection of books for the Friends Book Sale is growing in his garage.

Newsletter – Liz stated that the new edition of the Newsletter should come out in June to tie in with the opening of the new library. The date is still unclear, but Kevin stated that after the Donor Evening, the doors should be open to the public soon after. The **Grand Opening** will be in the fall. Kevin said that there will be a **ribbon cutting** with dignitaries. The Trustees did a **walk through with Selectmen** and some good "in construction" photos

were taken and will be available for the Newsletter. Liz said that it sounds like she will finish up the Newsletter in June and have it out by July. Kevin says that the Trustees will submit an article about the new Board.

Sddita Blackburn has been working on the logo since the fall and has been working with us asking for our vision for "branding the library". The new lettering on the outside of the library has impacted the process. The new logo marries the glass, zigzag and books of the library. The Friends logo will blend in with the library logo. It will be available for letterheads, website and swag.
